

Required Medical Documents

In accordance to NJ State laws, the Ramsey Board of Education requires that all registrants submit a completed physical examination form and an immunization record before the start of the school year. The physical form must be dated within 365 days from the start of the school year.

1. Physical Form – completed by physician

- A current physical should be submitted upon registration.
- If physical was not performed within the 365 days from the start of the school year, a new one must be submitted immediately upon completion.

2. Proof of Immunization – completed by physician and supplied by physician

- A current immunization record must be submitted at registration, regardless of physical exam date.
- Any subsequent immunization data should also be submitted immediately upon completion.

For Pre –School (18 mos. to 4 years), your child must have:

| 1. DTaP – 4 doses. | 5. Varicella (Chicken Pox) – 1 dose. |
| 2. Polio – 3 doses. | 6. PCV7 (Pneumococcal vaccine) – 1 dose.
(Given after 1 st birthday) |
| 3. MMR – 1 dose. | 7. Influenza – 1 dose annually (6 – 59 months).
(Given after 1 st birthday) |
| 4. Hib – 1 dose after 1 st birthday. | |

For Kindergarten, your child must have:

1. DTaP- 4 doses with one dose given on or after the 4th birthday or any 5 doses. If DT is substituted for DTaP, a written explanation from the child's physician MUST be provided.
2. Polio- 3 doses with one dose given on or after the 4th birthday or any 4 doses.
3. Measles, Mumps and Rubella- 2 doses of live vaccine MUST be given if born after 1/1/90 or laboratory evidence of immunity MUST be submitted.
4. Hepatitis B- 3 doses.
5. Varicella- 1 dose for chickenpox or laboratory evidence of immunity.

For 6th Grade, your child must have:

1. Tdap.
2. Meningitis.
